

Scope and Sequence



Second Grade

Phonics/Language

Lesson 1-30: Review of vowels, phonics chart 1-9, short vowels, blends, long vowels, two vowels, syllables, suffix-s, compound words, and root words.

Lesson 31-60: Phonics chart 10-12, days of the week, months, contractions, prefix, question marks, and doubling the consonant.

Lesson 61-91: Phonics chart 13, exclamation points, alphabetical order, capitalization, and plurals.

Lesson 91-170: Abbreviations, kinds of sentences, and review.

Reading

***Children will be grouped according to their reading ability.**

The book chosen will be according to the ability of the child.

Books include If Skies Be Blue, When the Sun Rises High, Open Doors, Hidden Treasures, All Kinds of Animals, and Growing Up Where Jesus Lived. Chapter books include Mouse and the Motorcycle, Charlotte's Web, Sarah Plain and Tall, James and the Giant Peach, Treasure of Pelican Cove and The Mystery of Pelican Cove. Students complete reading comprehension worksheets, complete book reports, and oral presentations.. **MONTHLY BOOK REPORTS WILL BE DUE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE MONTH. THE BOOK MUST HAVE AT LEAST 48 PAGES.**

Cursive Writing

Learn upper and lower case cursive writing and daily seatwork practice.

History and Geography

Science
